Parking and admission are free.

TV’s Ed Hume will speak at 1:00 pm on Friday as a free extra added attraction.

It all happens indoors – under one roof – in a comfortable, heated building. Restrooms and concessions are attached to the building. Loading is at ground level – lots of easy, nearby parking. Show hours are 10:00 am till 5:00 pm both days.

Plenty of time to set-up: Thursday before the sale, 9:00 am – 9:00 pm, Friday morning, 8:00 am – 10:00 am.

Your booth space is 12 feet wide by 8 feet deep, and comes with 2 tables and two chairs. Plus electric, at no additional charge. Total rent for the 2 days is just \$67.00. No additional percentages, commissions, or fees to pay. You are welcome to bring in any additional tables, displays, racks, whatever fits into your booth.

If you have not been with us for awhile – now is your chance to get back into the swing of things – business is good! We work hard to keep vendor fees affordable for you, and to give you the best local/regional showcases possible. So take advantage and sign-up now for this event.

A vendor application is enclosed – return yours today with your payment. Don’t miss out – this show has always filled up in the past.

You’ll receive a confirmation postcard in the mail approximately one week before the show. This postcard will have your booth number(s) on it. If there is any problem with your application – we’ll call you right away. Otherwise, your application and payment are considered “accepted” as soon as we receive them.
