

# *Southwest Washington Fair*

## *HASC Youth Challenges*

*Participation in all challenges will be based on the following criteria.*

- 1. Applicant is a youth between 9 and 19 years of age as of January 1, 2011.*
- 2. A fully completed entry form has been turned in to the fair office. An entry form must be submitted for each rider/horse combination.*

*More than one entry form may be submitted. Youth may qualify with more than one horse through the year. An entry form may be submitted for each show they have attended. Any incomplete entry form will be rejected.*

- 3. The individual class prerequisite has been met.*

*Prerequisites include the class must be a cantor/lope class as well as the youth and horse combination must have placed 1st through 5th in the class type. The placement must be in the top half of the class (i.e., 4th place out of 8 horses qualifies; 4th place out of 4 horses does not qualify). This must be a placing in a single class, not an overall event or high-point placing. If there is a question if the placing qualifies, submit the entry form and HASC will make an evaluation. The placement must have been on or after January 1, 2011. Class types are:*

*English Equitation   Stock Seat/Western Equitation   Trail   Western Games*

- 4. Space is available. All challenge class sizes will be a total of 15, except for gaming which will be 25.*

*SWW Fair youth will be considered for participation in 10 (20 for gaming) available slots. Half of the SWW Fair youth slots will be drawn from pre-entries received by July 18, 2011. The rest of the pre-entries will go into a general pool to fill the remaining slots with all the other entries received until the day of the challenge.*

*Five slots are guaranteed to NonSWW Fair youth. If there are more qualified entries than space available, participation will be by random draw on July 29, 2011. If these five slots are not filled by July 18, 2011 by nonSWW Fair youth, the slots may be filled by youth attending the SWW Fair.*

*HASC will conduct all random drawings.*

- 5. Parent or guardian has signed S<sup>W</sup>W Fair grounds release on the entry form.*

*Management reserves the right to ask any applicant to verify their prerequisite for any challenge. Management also reserves the right to exclude any applicant for safety concerns.*

*For nonS<sup>W</sup>W Fair participants, haul in and vet check is between 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. the day of the challenge.*

*For those applicants attending the S<sup>W</sup>W Fair, a list of the potential challenge applicant pool for the day will be posted at the HASC office each morning. Applicants may confirm their entry has been accepted for the challenge.*
